R.M. of St. Laurent Call for Quotes Porta-Potty Maintenance

The R.M. of St. Laurent invites local quotes for regular cleaning of the porta potties at Meindl Park (Venice), Big Tree Park (Sandpiper) and Laurentia Park. Days include weekends and long weekends, with up to two days during the week or as needed (usually Mondays and Thursdays).

Quote should include cleaning supplies, mileage and your time and should be on a lump sum/complete quote basis for the time period from May 18th, 2025 up to and including September 13th, 2025. The RM will calculate and pay out on a bi-weekly basis.

Requirement to communicate with the CAO/RM if the unit is in need of repairs, sewage removal or water replenishment. RM will be responsible for toilet paper, paper towels, hand soap, water supply, sewage pump-out and repairs to the units as needed and may prorate your quote should the timeframe indicated above be shortened or lengthened on any or all units due to unforeseen circumstances.

Effective March 5, 2025, the Rural Municipality passed the third reading for the new Waste Management By-Law #6/2025. This by-law repeals the previous Waste Transfer Site By-Law 1/14.

Under the new by-law, starting April 2, 2025, municipal ratepayers will be charged a tipping fee for any oversized furniture that is brought to the waste transfer site. Oversized furniture includes and is not limited to couches and mattresses with box springs.

In addition, **non residents and ratepayers** are now permitted to attend the waste transfer site; however, will be required to pay tipping fees for various items as described in the Schedule B of the by-law, which is herein attached.

The Municipality will have a pin pad available at the Waste Transfer Site to accept tipping fee payments via debit only. **Cash will not be accepted.**

La Municipalité rurale de Saint-Laurent sollicite des devis locaux pour le nettoyage régulier des toilettes portatives du parc Meindl (Venice), du parc Big Tree (Sandpiper) et du parc Laurentia. Les jours de nettoyage comprennent les fins de semaine et les longs week-ends, avec un maximum de deux jours par semaine ou selon les besoins (généralement les lundis et jeudis).

Le devis doit inclure les fournitures de nettoyage, le kilométrage et votre temps, et doit être forfaitaire/complet pour la période du 18 mai 2025 au 13 septembre 2025 inclus. La Municipalité rurale calculera et paiera toutes les deux semaines.

Le 5 mars 2025, la municipalité rurale a adopté en troisième lecture le nouveau règlement n° 6/2025 sur la gestion des déchets. Ce règlement abroge le précédent règlement n° 1/14 sur le site de transfert des déchets.
